Every year we try to plant edible perennials in our garden. Our goal is that over time we'll have more harvest with less work each season. Learning to eat what we have is a big part of reaching this goal. While I would love to have spinach whenever I want it, it only grows for a short season here. However, the moringa produces for about nine months here and it's a perennial vegetable, so we content ourselves with moringa instead of spinach.
